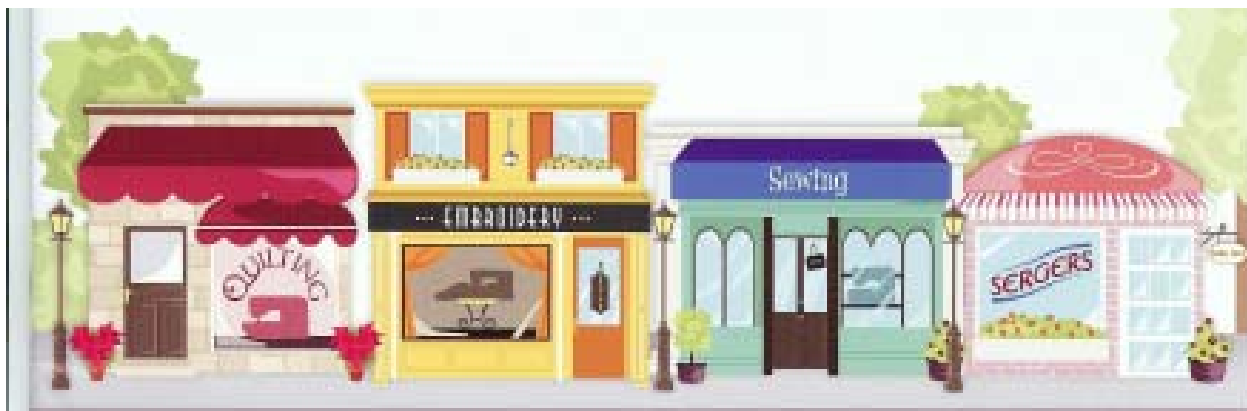

Classroom Policy and Procedures

It is necessary to pre-register for all classes. Payment is due upon registration. When you register, **please request a supply list for your class.** Supplies are not included in class fees unless otherwise stated. All Students receive a 15% discount on class supplies purchased here. If you are unable to bring a machine to class let us know and we will provide a machine for you. We make a commitment to our teachers one week prior to class time. Therefore, no refunds will be made after this point. In the event class is cancelled by the teacher, low enrollment or inclement weather, students who are registered and paid will receive a refund, store credit or may apply fees to another class. To help prevent cancellations due to low enrollment, students are encouraged to register early.
